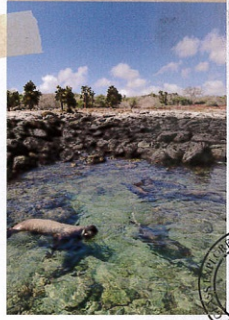


überHaus chalet
