Join us for a long weekend of truffle hunting, wine tasting, cooking demonstrations, and antique markets ... all on an "à la carte" basis ... it is YOUR weekend.



Once again this Autumn, we are holding our hugely popular truffle and wine weekends. November is a perfect time of year to visit Provence. A beautiful calm descends over the countryside and the scent of roasting chestnuts drifts through the village markets. It can be surprisingly warm and it is a great time to explore the region.

Our long weekend programme is designed to give you all of the benefits of an organised group with access to things not usually available to individual travellers. ## When

### Thursday

Arrival, Welcome Drinks Party and Dinner.

### Friday

Breakfast. Cooking demonstration with our chef in the Hotel kitchens. Tasting at Château La Nerthe (for example) in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Dinner at the Hotel.

### Saturday

Breakfast. Truffle hunting with expert *truffier* in nearby village with rustic lunch. Comfortable shoes and warm clothes recommended. Afternoon free. Dinner with full truffle specialties.

### Sunday

Breakfast. Visit to Isle-sur-la-Sorgue for morning farmers' market and antique shops and stands. Departure.

It does not include: lunches (except the truffle lunch), wine and other beverages, transportation to or from Crillon le Brave, mini-bar or other personal items.
